- 3. Östarps Gästgivaregård
  Here you can have lunch or coffee,
  see signs for opening hours.
- 4. The Windmill

  The windmill was moved here in 1924.
- 5. Möllegården/Mölle Farm
  Private, for the owner of the animals
- 6. Brytestugan Was used to dry and break flax, the plant used for linen.

7. The Malt House

Was used to dry malt for brewing beer.

- 8. The Watermill
  Was primarily used to grinde rye.
- 9. Gamlegård/The Old Farm
  Typical Scanian farm. Rebuilt in 1812
  after a big fire. During the summer
  season you can have a look inside.
- 10. Gamlegård's Garden
  A lot of Hanna Jöns Persson's garden
  from the late 19th century is still intact.
- Alrik's Farm
   Not open to visitors yet.
