


KULTUREN



Kulturen in Lund is a museum and an open-air museum that stretches over two blocks, the **North and South area**. These are linked by the **Underpass** (No. 8 on the map), a tunnel under the street. If you can't use the tunnel staircase, you can reach the northern area via the **Green Gate** (No. 34). Ask the entrance staff or hosts for help.
