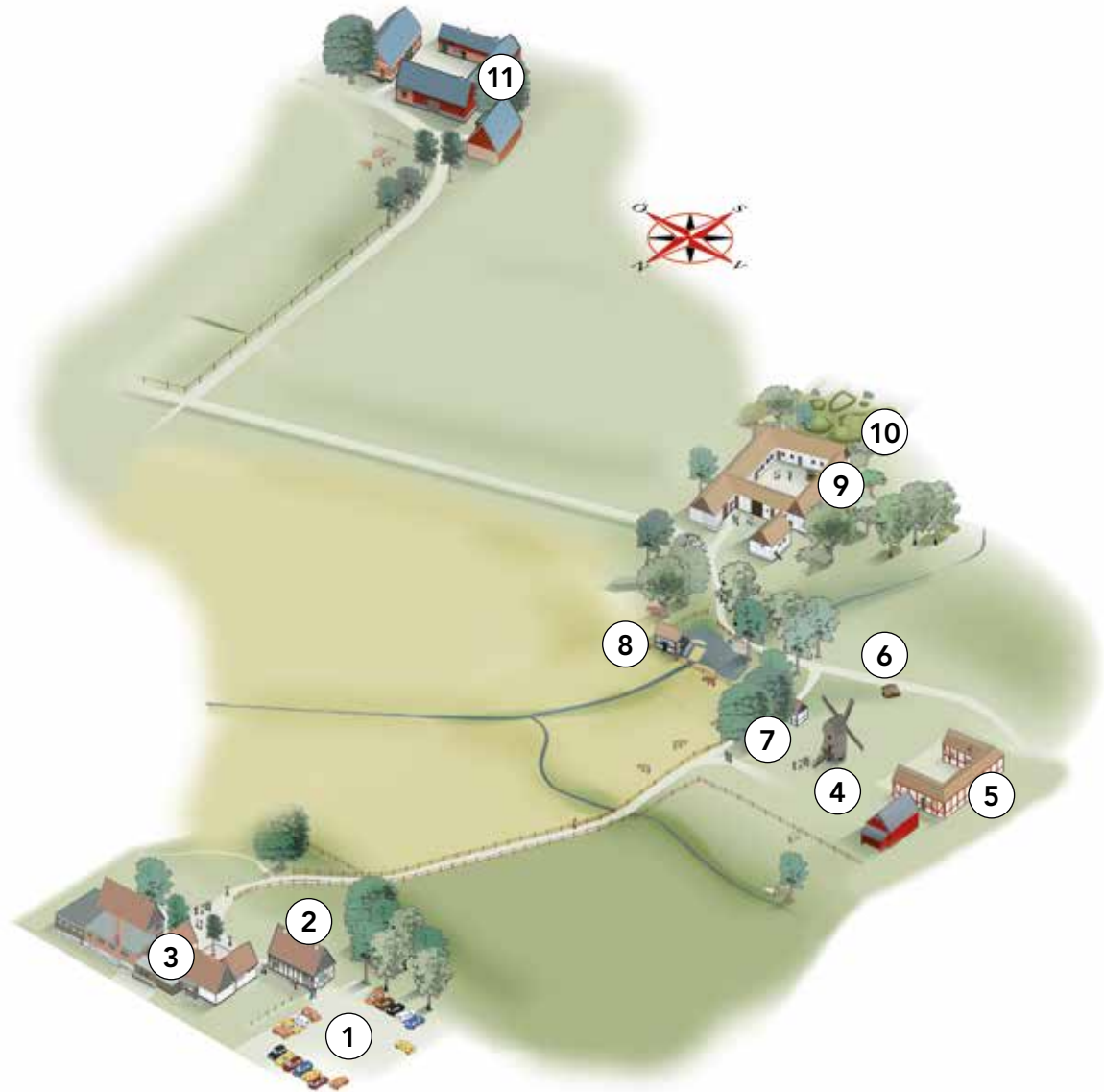


Welcome to Kulturen's Östarp!



1. Parking

2. The Östarp Hall

Information point & visitor maps.

3. Östarp's Summer Café

Visit Östarp's Summer Café. Opening hours are posted on a sign outside.

4. The Windmill

A windmill used for grinding grain. This type is known as a "stubbamölla".

5. Möllegården

Built by the museum in 1924. Used by staff and not open to visitors.

6. The Flax Shed

For drying and processing flax.

7. The Malthouse

For drying malt for brewing beer.

8. The Watermill

A grain mill with a mill pond.

9. Gamlegård – The Old Farm

A half-timbered farmstead built in the 1810s. Open to visitors during the summer season. See signs for opening hours.

10. Gamlegård's garden

See the legacy of Hanna Jöns Persson's garden from the late 19th century.

11. Brödragården – The Brother's Farm

A well-built early 20th-century farm. Open during guided tours.
